_____ Number of Hot Spots visited May 1 thru May 31, 2021. Submit your entry form with a list of sites visited and date you were there.

_____ Rarest bird seen. Submit your entry form with the species of bird, where and when you saw it, and a written description of how you identified it. If you have a picture, submit that also.

_____ Best photo or drawing. Submit your entry form with an original drawing done by you, or a photo taken by you personally.

RULES OF BIRDING CHALLENGE

All entries must be accompanied by documentation to support the categories being entered.

Any photo or art work must be originals. Photos and a photo of art work can be submitted digitally thru email. If an actual photo or artwork is submitted it will not be returned.

There will be two prizes awarded in each category. One for children (15 and younger) and one for adults (16 and older).

Rarest bird and photo/artwork categories will be judged by the Chequamegon Bird Club's WMBD committee. In case of a tie in the species and hot spots visited categories, all tie entries will be put into a drawing for the prize.

Entries must be submitted by June 15, 2021 in order to qualify.

This challenge is about going out and having fun! Enjoy the experience, but be respectful. Avoid stressing birds or exposing them to danger and always minimize habitat disturbance. For more information on birding and birding ethics go to www.aba.org.
